1. Page no. 63, in the line below expression (4a), please read: “...where $\gamma > 0$ and γ is the elasticity component...”
2. Page no. 63, in the line below expression (4b), please read: “... where $\alpha \geq 0$ and $\gamma \geq 0$.”
3. Page no. 64, please read 'Bhatnagar (2001)' in place of 'Batnagar (2001)'.
4. Page no. 65, in the paragraph just above expression (7a*), please read: “However, if we follow the footnote 10, as above, it does **not** pose any **serious** threat to the application of the method as long as it is applied to the whole range of income.”
